## **APPLICATION:**

**Indofil Oil UR 0715** is to be added to the drum by pre dissolving with other fatliquors & water. It is recommended for all types of full grain, corrected grain uppers, suede, nubucks, gloving and milled articles

**Indofil Oil UR 0715** is having wide range of applications as follows,

For Cow/Buff full grain & corrected grain : 2% - 6% in fatliquoring

For nappa and gloving leathers : 4% - 10% in fatliquoring

For suede & nubuck leathers : 3% - 6% in fatliquoring

In Rechroming : 1% - 4% in Rechroming

**STORAGE STABILITY:** 6-9 months if properly stored in cool & dry place under shed in sealed drums. It is recommended to stir well the product before each & every use.
